

The Aditya Birla Integrated School

A highly specialised School, it will integrate students who learn differently. The aim is to offer a holistic, multi-disciplinary education programme to students who have learning disabilities. The endeavour is to give the learners everything under one roof with academics, remediation therapies, counselling and co-curricular activities all being part of the school hours itself and with a small student teacher ratio.

The team comprises of special educators, resource educators and teacher aides, occupational therapists, speech and language therapists, behaviour therapists, clinical psychologists, animal assisted pet therapists and art based therapists.

There will be two parallel academic programs –

1) The Inclusive Educational Programme: (Grades 1-12) meant primarily for children with learning disabilities. The student teacher ratio will be 10:1. Children in this program will be geared toward the NIOS board.

2) The Differentiated Learning Programme will be catering to students with Developmental Delays and Autism. They will be taught using Individualized Educational Programmes. The goal here is Functional Skill development. The student teacher ratio will be 5:1.

Alongside daily, a compulsory co-curricular program that will incorporate sports, judo, gym, art, music, dance, theatre, games, chess and robotics, will be conducted.

The overarching mission is – Inspiring Potential to create happy, confident, balanced and independent learners whilst nurturing the qualities of Amity, Bravery, Integrity and Sincerity.
