Regular Callido sessions for learning 21st Century skills are conducted for A level and IB DP students of Grades 11 and 12. Students with special needs are supported actively by teachers and the SEN team. Gifted and talented students practice with more challenging assignments to kindle their latent talents and keep them actively involved in the curriculum.

Students are also trained to successfully participate in inter-house matches for football, basketball, cricket, table tennis and chess as well as inter-school tournaments, such as DSO & MSSA. The school teams travel to Europe annually and participate in football tournaments.

A well-qualified and experienced Counselling team patiently and attentively works with students both individually and in a group setting to help them resolve their issues and raise their self-esteem.
